

## HONORS ELECTIVE SUBSTITUTIONS

Type of Course/Experience & # of Honors elective units received	Action Needed by Student
Internships not connected to a 198i (Number of units will be contingent on number of hours/week, type of work, and length of work as determined by the Faculty Director.)	BEFORE you complete an internship w/o course credit, contact your Honors counselor to discuss your internship. If it is eligible for honors elective credit, you can submit the petition form after you complete the experience. Honors will update this in DegreeWorks 1-2 weeks after form submission.
Graduate Coursework (Number of units equivalent to course(s) taken)	AFTER you complete any graduate coursework and pass with a D+ or better, contact your Honors counselor for the petition form. Honors will update this in DegreeWorks 1-2 weeks after form submission.
Study Abroad, UCDC, UCCS (Number of units equivalent to course(s) taken as it relates to these experiences)	AFTER you complete the experience and pass the affiliated courses with a D+ or better, contact your Honors counselor for the petition form. Honors will update this in DegreeWorks 1-2 weeks after form submission.
Students completing the R'course teaching experience  (Although teaching the R'course is typically a 3 unit experience over 3 quarters, you will receive 4 units of Honors elective credit for completing this experience.)	AFTER you successfully complete the preparatory courses (XXX190 and EDUC 102) that instruct you how to teach an R'course and then teach the R'course, contact your Honors counselors for the petition form. Honors will update this in DegreeWorks 1-2 weeks after form submission.
Students completing research units (Number of units equivalent to research unit(s) completed)	BEFORE you take research units for honors elective credit, contact your Honors counselor to check if they are eligible. You cannot use research units that are being applied to the Honors capstone for honors elective credit. If it is eligible for honors elective credit, you can submit the petition form after you complete the research units. Honors will update this in DegreeWorks 1-2 weeks after form submission.
Students completing research opportunities (this list is not exhaustive):  <b>(1) California Alliance for Minority Participation (CAMP)</b> <b>(2) Chancellor's Research Fellowship (CRF)</b> <b>(3) Prestigious Scholarships &amp; Awards that involve the pursuit of a rigorous undergraduate research opportunity (Strauss, Goldwater, Mellon Mays, etc.)</b> <b>(4) Maximizing Access to Research Careers - Undergraduate Student Training in Academic Research (MARC*)</b> <b>(5) Mentoring Summer Research Internship Program (MSRIP)</b> <b>(6) UC Leadership Excellence through Advanced Degrees (UCLEADS)</b>  (As these programs are variable and may or may not involve course(s) attached to the experience, each experience can count for up to 4 units of Honors elective units.)	BEFORE you have been admitted to a research program, check with your honors counselor regarding eligibility of any research program to count for honors elective credit. Generally, they will only count if the research is consistent with the research required for an honors capstone project and must include a presentation component. For example, only attending CAMP workshops would not count for honors elective units.  If you are eligible to submit a petition form, you will need to provide e-mail proof that you were accepted into the program(s) and an e-mail from your faculty-mentor indicating that you completed an undergraduate research project with a presentation.

Type of Course/Experience & # of Honors elective units received	Action Needed by Student
HASS 100 Leadership (Number of units equivalent to course(s) taken)	No petition form needed. Once you complete this course and pass with a D+ or better, the course will automatically populate in Degreeworks as counting for Honors elective credit.
HNPG003/HNPG004 (2 units)	No petition form needed. These courses are a continuation of HNPG002W if a student decides to pursue a community service project over the two following quarters. Student should contact the Faculty Director if interested in this option.
Honors elective courses that do not have the typical "H" designation, e.g., EST001H, but are listed in the Honors elective courses sheet for any given quarter, e.g., PSYC182E. The updated Honors courses sheet can be found under "Current Honors Course Offerings" - <a href="https://honors.ucr.edu/current-students/courses">https://honors.ucr.edu/current-students/courses</a> (Number of units equivalent to course(s) taken)	No petition form needed. Once you complete this course and pass with a D+ or better, the course will automatically populate in Degreeworks as counting for Honors elective credit.
Internships connected to a 198i (Number of units connected to internship)	No petition form needed. Once you complete this course and pass the course, it will automatically populate in Degreeworks as counting for Honors elective credit.
Honors Contract Course (Number of units in the upper division course you take under this option)	No petition form needed. Once you submit the Honors contract course form found here: <a href="https://honors.ucr.edu/current-students/courses">https://honors.ucr.edu/current-students/courses</a> complete the course per the instructions, and you will receive credit in DegreeWorks once you pass the course with a D+ or better.
