



# ADMITTED STUDENTS TRANSFERS: NEXT STEPS

Once a transfer student has applied and is officially admitted to University Honors, please see the following for next steps.



## 1. Ensure you will be at UCR minimum 2 years

Transfer admits must graduate no sooner than spring 2028 to allow themselves time to complete all University Honors requirements.




## 2. Attend Virtual University Honors Workshop

Attend University Honors Virtual Student Workshop prior to Highlander Orientation for Transfers to learn about University Honors course requirements in preparation for registration.



## 3. Attend Highlander Orientation for Transfers

Highlander Orientation is a mandatory program that consists of a one-day orientation session AND a half day virtual advising appointment.



## 4. Enroll in HNPG149 (Introduction to Capstone)

Enroll in HNPG149 for fall 2026. This course will assist you in securing a faculty-mentor.



## 5. Secure a Faculty-Mentor

All students will need to secure a faculty-mentor for their eventual capstone project by the end of fall quarter. This is completed via a signed Faculty-Mentor Contract provided in HNPG149.

Thoroughly review the third-year and fourth-year University Honors requirements and recognize that they all must be satisfied to graduate with University Honors distinction.
